

Medicare Team Care Arrangements

What is a Medicare Team Care Arrangement? Your team care arrangement (TCA) gives you access to allied health professionals at a reduced cost.

You will get referrals for five visits to allied health providers. Medicare will pay for part of these visits. You can use these visits with one provider or between different providers.

How do I get my Team Care Arrangement?

- 1 Book an appointment with your GP - let reception know you need a TCA
- 2 Chat with your GP to confirm the type of health professionals you would like to see
- 3 Your GP will provide up to five referrals across your required health professionals (Medicare will pay for part of these visits)
- 4 Attend appointments
- 5 Renew your TCA each calendar year for five new appointments

FAQs

What is an allied health professional?

These include many specialists such as dietitians, psychologists, diabetes nurse educators, exercise physiologists, etc

What are the costs to get a Team Care Arrangement?

Your GP will charge you their appointment fee.

How much do the allied health professionals charge? How much is covered and what is out of pocket?
